This Indenture, Made this 18 day of March, 1902 between W. J. Hamilton and S. M. Hamilton, his wife of the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, hereinafter called the Mortgagors, and John W. Attwell, of the County of Wasco and State of Oregon hereinafter called the Mortgagee. Witnesseth That the said Mortgagors for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-two hundred and thirty six (2236⁰⁰/₁₀₀) Dollars, United States Gold Coin, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do Grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mortgagee, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns those certain premises situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, and described as follows, to-wit:
