Interest to be paid at maturity and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note, or any portion thereof, we promise and agree to pay, in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute, such additional sum, in like Gold Coin, as the Court may adjudge reasonable, for attorney's fees to be allowed in said suit or action.

Franklin Short fail to pay either of said notes at maturity or any installment of interest due upon either, then the whole amount unpaid shall become at once due whether due by lapse of time or not at the option of the holder of said notes.

This mortgage is given upon the following conditions, to wit:

The said mortgagor shall upon the payment to it of five (5) dollars per acre release from said mortgage any portion of said lands hereby mortgaged in case said mortgagors shall find a purchaser for such portion, provided however, that said lot one (1) of section thirty-six (36) shall not be released from said mortgage until said mortgage indebtedness shall fully paid.
