This Indenture Witnesseth, That Roger Hunter + Isabella M. Hunter his wife parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty Five ^{00/100} Dollars, to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents he bargain, sell and convey unto H. L. Powers party of the second part, the following described premises, to-wit:

Southeast quarter (1/4) Section Twenty-two (22) Township three (3) north seven (7) east.

Together with the ~~hereditaments~~ hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and hold the same, with the appurtenances, unto the said H. L. Powers heirs and assigns forever.

This Conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty Five ^{00/100} (\$425.00) Dollars in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to-wit:

Ninety days after date, without grace, I promise to pay to H. L. Powers or order, Four hundred twenty five Dollars, in U. S. Gold Coin, for value received, with interests after date in like coin, at the rate
