Together with all and singular the rights, privileges, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any way incident or appertaining.

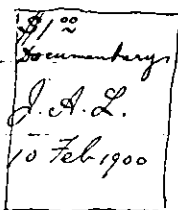
