

in the payment of the principal & interest, as above provided. Then the said promissory note shall at the option of the legal owner and holder thereof, at once become due and payable, and such owner and holder by reason thereof may foreclose this mortgage at any time thereafter, and sell the premises above described, with all and every of the appurtenances, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of the money arising from such sale, retain the said principal and interest, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and the overplus if any there be, paid over to the said Alfred C. Good & Katy Good his wife heirs or assigns. In case a suit is instituted to foreclose this mortgage for any of the reasons herein contained, the plaintiff in such suit shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court shall adjudge reasonable as attorney's fee therein, and the said parties of the first part for their heirs, executors and administrators do covenant and agree to pay the said party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns the said sum of money as above mentioned.
