

F. M. Broadbent to Henry W. Coe

This Indenture, made the third day of March in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred, between F. M. Broadbent of the County of Lewis and State of Washington party of the first, and Henry W. Coe of the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon party of the second part. Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Seventy five (\$175.00) Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quit-claimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns the mineral lode as located, surveyed, recorded and held by said party of the first part, situated in Saint Helens Mining District in the County of Skamania State of Washington and better known and described as follows:

The undivided five eighths ($\frac{5}{8}$) of the Norway discovery Claim more fully described as follows:-

Beginning at a point one hundred and fifty (150) feet North West of the Mouth of Tunnel on said claim and running fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a South Easterly direction, and three hundred (300) feet on each side of the Center line of said claim. Said claim is about one (1) mile Southerly of what is known as Spirit Lake, and was originally located by W. W. O'Connor.

Also the undivided one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Mineral Lode and claim known as the North West Chicago No. Two (2), situated in said Saint Helens Mining District in Skamania County, State of Washington, said claim or lode being more particularly described as follows:-

Said Claim was originally located by J. Dark, who forfeited his rights thereto by failing to do his assessment work, and was subsequently located by the Grantor herein. It is fifteen hundred linear feet on the Chicago Lode of the Saint Helens Mining District aforesaid, and adjoins Chicago Extension Claim No. One (1). Said claim runs in a Northwesterly direction, is six hundred feet in width, and is 3000 feet North West of Chicago Discovery Claim.

Together with all the dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the rights, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also, all
