Horton, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, free from all claim thereon on the part of the said Elsie E Howard, W D Howard, Charles T. Howard & Jennie E Tanton or anyone claiming the same by, or through, or under them in any manner whatsoever.
