THE REMAINING LAND COULD BE SCARIFIED AND PLANTED UNDER THE FEDERALLY FUNDED PROGRAMS.

A CABLE SYSTEM WOULD SCARIFY THE STEEPER PORTIONS & CAT ON THE LEVEL PORTIONS (SEE MAP).

STREAMSIDE MANAGEMENT ZONES WOULD BE REQUIRED ALONG BOTH STREAMS. SOILS IN THE AREA ARE CLAY LOAM & WOULD TEND TO ERODE IF PROTECTIVE MEASURES WERE NOT TAKEN.

THE CONIFERS ARE LARGE & SHOULD BE REMOVED SO AS NOT TO CAUSE HARM TO THE PLANNED REPRODUCTION.

IMMEDIATELY UPON COMPLETION OF SCARIFICATION & LOGGING ((NOV-DEC)) PLANTING OF 2-0 DOUG FIR IS SUGGESTED. AT 600 TREES TO THE ACRE ((8'x8' SPACING)).
