Commencing at the center corner stake of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec 25. thence running 46 rods East thence 80 rods South thence 46 rods West thence north 80 rods to place of beginning part of the S.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of S. 25 - 3 - 7 1/2 E. W. comprising 23 acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, privileges, improvements, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any way incident or appertaining.

To Have And To Hold unto the said Jackson Grouch his heirs and assigns forever and the title to the foregoing described premises, and every part thereof we bind ourselves and our heirs and legal representatives to forever warrant and defend unto the said Jackson Grouch and to his heirs, assigns and legal representatives against the lawful claims of all persons claiming, or to claim, the same or any part thereof.
