Know all Men by these Presents, That we Archer C. Walling and Lulu Walling, husband and wife, of the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to us in hand paid by the Skamania Logging Company, a corporation, of the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge we have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Skamania Logging Company and to its successors and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the North East quarter and the East half of the South East quarter of Section seven (7), in Township two (2) North, of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty (160) acres

Together with all and singular the tenements, ^{300 ch.} ^{Ar. C. W.} ¹⁹⁰⁰ ^{Documentary} hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.

To have and to hold, the same unto the said Skamania Logging Company and to its successors and assigns forever, and we do hereby covenant with the said grantee, its successors and assigns, that at the date hereof we are well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
