

Water Right.

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that W.A.Orser of Chenoweth Skamania County Washington hereby claims and appropriates the water lying and being in the Little White Salmon River in Skamania County Washington to the extent of five hundred (500) cubic feet per second of time. The point of diversion of said water being at a point about eighty rods northerly from the point where said Little White Salmon river crosses the North line of Section one Township three North of Range nine East of Willamette Meridian. The purpose for which said water is claimed and appropriated is for domestic, irrigation and manufacturing purposes and the place where water is intended to be used is in the Chenoweth Valley and Underwood Valley and upon the property of the said W.A.Orser in the said Valley. That the means by which it is intended to ~~##~~ divert said water is by flume ditch or pipe line of sufficient size to carry all of the said water appropriated to the point of use.

Frink to Church.

Know all men by these presents: That I, Minnie Frink, of Portland, county of Multnomah, state of Oregon, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute, and appoint Charles P.Church, of Portland, county of Multnomah, state of Oregon, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place, and stead to appropriate water in any lake, pond, or flowing stream in the state of Washington and the right to the use of water flowing in any river, stream, or ravine of said state for irrigation, mining, or manufacturing purposes, or for supplying cities, towns, or villages with water or for water works and:

To that end to post any or all notices in writing at the point of intended storage or diversion, laying claim to the water there lying, being or flowing; to commence and carry to completion the construction of the works by which it is intended to store, or divert the said water, to sell, and transfer my interest in such water rights with the lease-hold, free-hold interests in any lands used or obtained by virtue of said water right to whom and on such terms as my said attorney may deem best, and by such instrument or means as may be agreed between him and any other parties; to execute such instruments in writing to sell or otherwise give acknowledgment, therefor as may be necessary to carry out the full intent of this my power of attorney to the said Charles P. Church.

Giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney or his substitute shall lawfully do, or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
