

P. H. Hultgren to Henry W. Coe.

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, P. H. Hultgren a single man of the city of Portland, Multnomah Co State of Oregon, in consideration of One Dollar, to me paid by Henry W. Coe State of Oregon, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Henry W. Coe his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington a full undivided one thirty-second interest in a certain mining claim described as follows:

Fifteen Hundred (1500) Linear feet on the Chicago Lode, situated in St. Helens Mining District, State of Washington and divided as follows: - Beginning at the terminus of the Chicago Discovery Claim and running fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a Northwesterly direction and three hundred (300) feet on each side of centre of vein. This Claim is situated fifteen hundred (1500) feet North Westerly of and adjoining the original discovery claim, near the head of the North Toltle River

An undivided one-thirty second  $\frac{1}{32}$  in said claim, being hereby transferred to said Henry W. Coe from said P. H. Hultgren - Said claim known as Chicago Extension No one.
