Assignment of Water Right.

This instrument witnesseth that on the 19th day of May 1905, W.A.Wendorf filed a certain water right in Skamania County State of Washington, a copy of said filing is as follows, to-wit: Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, claim the water now running flowing or being in a small spring to the extent of one cubic foot per second of time. Said spring is situated on or near the middle of the dividing line between the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 T 3 N of R.10 E of W.M. The water so claimed is for irrigation and domestic purposes. The place of diversion is at the location of said spring. The means of diversion is by flume, ditch or pipe which said flume ditch or pipe will run in an easterly direction by best possible route.

Now therefore, we, W.A.Wendorf and Helen L.Wendorf his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we do hereby sell, transfer and convey to J.L.Wendorf a one half interest in and to all of said water right and the pipes, ditches or other means used to divert said water. With full right and authority to go upon and along said pipe or ditch line for such purposes as may be necessary in connection with said water right. We also give to said J.L.Wendorf his heirs and assigns the right to lay a galvanized water pipe of such

dimension as may be necessary to carry said water along over and across the following described land and maintain the same thereon with the privilege of going upon the said land for the purpose of making all necessary repairs theron or thereto, beginning at a point 56 rods west of the southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of said section 16 Town 3 North of Range 10 E.W.M., running thence north 40 rods, thence west 24 rods, thence South 40 rods, thence east 24 rods to place of beginning, containing six (6) acres. That the right hereby given shall be used in such manner as not to injure said property. Said pipe shall be laid at a depth of 22 inches.

Water Right

To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby given that W.A.Orser of Chenowith Skamania County Washington hereby claims and appropriates the water lying being or flowing in the Lava Creek in Skamania County Washington to the extent of fifty cubic feet per second of time. The point of diversion of said water being at a point fifty rods more or less above the point where the County Road crosses said Lava Creek. The purpose for which said water is claimed and appropriated is for domestic, irrigation and manufacturing purposes and the place where water is intended to be used is in the Chenowith Valley and Underwood Valley and upon the property of W.A.Orser in said Valley. That the means by which said water is intended to be diverted is by flume ditch or pipe line of sufficient size to carry all said water so appropriated to point of use.
