


as its property for the payment of said note at maturity thereof. Now should the said Ed Underwood fail, neglect or refuse to perform all the conditions of this instrument at proper time or should she neglect or allow said crop to go to waste or be destroyed or damaged, either in whole or part, or should default be made in the payment of the said principal sum, or any installment of interest thereon, or should the said Ed Underwood sell or dispose of, or attempt to sell or dispose of, or remove or attempt to remove out of said County said property, or any part thereof, without first obtaining the written consent of the said Davidson Fruit Co. or suffer the same, or any part thereof, to be taken on attachment or execution, then it shall be lawful for the said Davidson Fruit Co. its assigns or legal representatives, with the aid and assistance of any person or persons whatsoever, to enter any place or places where the said goods and chattels may be found, and take and carry away the same, and the same to sell or dispose of at public or private sale as it may see fit, and out of the proceeds arising from such sale to retain and pay the sums above mentioned, and costs and expenses and reasonable charges for making such sale, together with its reasonable attorney's fees, and the surplus, if any there be, pay to the said Ed Underwood, his heirs or legal representatives.
