

Water Right.

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that C.H.Cromwell of Chenoweth Washington he hereby claims and appropriates the water lying being or flowing in Little white Salmon River in Skamania County Washington to the extent of three hundred (300) cubic feet per second of time. The point of diverting the said water being at a point about eighty rods northerly from the point where said little white salmon river crosses the north line of section one Township three North of Range nine East of Willamette Meridian. The purposes for which said water is claimed and appropriated is for irrigation, domestic and manufacturing purposes and the places of where water is intended to be used is in the Chenoweth Valley and Underwood Valley and upon the property of C.H.Cromwell. That the means by which said water is intended to be diverted is by flume ditch or pipe of sufficient size to carry all of said water appropriated to the point of use.
