F. Sweeney party of the second part, the following described premises, to-wit: The East half of the South West Quarter and Lots Three (3) and Four (4) of Section Thirty (30) of Township Four (4) North of Range Eight East of Willamette Meridian, containing One Hundred and Eight acres in Klamath County, Washington. Together with tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold, the same with the appurtenances, unto the said J. F. Sweeney his heirs and assigns forever.
