

Power of Attorney.

Know allmen by these presents that I, Emma S. Giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform any and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about said premises as fully to all interests and purposes as I might or could do if personally present hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
