

thence 600 linear feet South; thence 1500 linear feet East and thence 300 linear feet North to the place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's office July 3 1895, in Vol. 4 of mining records at page 48.

9 - The West-discovery Claim of the West Samson lode, discovered and located June 17 1895, by A. Mould and described and bounded as follows. Beginning at the point of discovery below a high cliff West of the Samson Excelsior lode, discovered at a Burnt-Stump of a fir tree about thirty feet high on the South slope of Star Mountain about one mile North West of Camp Samson, running thence 300 feet North and thence 1500 feet West; thence 600 feet South; thence 1500 feet East; and thence three hundred feet North to the place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's office July 3, 1895, in Vol 4 of mining records at page 49.

10 - The East-discovery claim of the West-Samson Lode; discovered and located June 17, 1895 by F. Ludloff and described and bounded as follows:- Beginning at the same point of discovery as the claim last-described and running thence 300 feet North; thence 1500 feet East; thence 600 feet South; thence 1500 feet West; thence 300 feet North to place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's Office July 3, 1895 in volume 4 of mining records at page 49.

11 - The North West Discovery Claim of the Samson Excelsior Lode, discovered and located June 17, 1895 by F. Ludloff and described and bounded as follows:- Beginning at point of discovery about 500 feet west from the Samson Superior Lode discovered in a Gulch born in the pumicestone above the cliffs of Samson gulch in the Upper Turtle River Basin about 30 feet North 75° West from the roots of a big windfall and running thence 300 feet North 5° East; thence 1500 feet North 85° West; thence 600 feet South 5° West thence 1500 feet South 85° East; thence 300 feet North 5° East to the place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's office July 3, 1895. in Vol 4 of mining records on page 50.
