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to-wit; the said Ronald Calkins, on behalf of Krohn Logging, Inc. and Louisiana-Pacific Corporation, agreed to pay said Kurt Miller and Gordon Walters for such labor and assistance the sum of \$9.00 per thousand board feet for falling and bucking of said timber; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Kurt Miller and Gordon Walters, who performed labor upon and assisted in falling and bucking said timber under the "Wind" sale for the period of thirty (30) days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said "Wind" sale between the 8th day of September, 1977 and the 30th day of September, 1977; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 30th day of September, 1977, and thirty (30) days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants' demand for said service is \$4,500.00; that no part thereof has been paid except \$2,300.00 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$2,200.00, which amount they claim as a lien upon said saw logs, spars and piling and manufactured timber therefrom. The said Kurt Miller and Gordon Walters also claim their lien on all said saw logs, spars and pilings now owned by said Louisiana-Pacific Corporation, Krohn Logging, Inc. and Ronald Calkins of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said saw logs, spars, piles or other timber herein described.
