Ludlogg and described and bounded as follows: - Beginning at the place of location above the steep cliffs of Samson Gulch in the North Fork of the river basin in creek bed and running thence 300 feet North 45° East; thence 1500 feet North 45° West; thence 600 feet South 45° West; thence 1500 feet South 45° East; thence 300 feet North 45° East to place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's office July 3rd, 1895 in Vol. 4 of mining records, at page 51.

14 - The South Eastern Discovery Claim of the Samson Superior Lode, discovered and located June 17 1895 by A. Wold and described and bounded as follows: - Beginning at the same place of Discovery as that of the claim last above described and running thence 300 feet North 45° East; thence 1500 feet South 45° East; thence 600 feet South 45° West; thence 1500 feet North 45° West; and thence 300 feet North 45° East to the place of beginning; Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's office July 3 1895 in Vol. 4 of Mining records at page 52.

15 - The North West Discovery Claim of the Samson Junior Lode, discovered and located June 17, 1895, by K. Ludlogg and described and bounded as follows: - Beginning at the place of discovery in Samson Gulch upper fork river basin about 50 paces South of Northeast corner of the North Samson claim near the eastern boundary line of the eastern slope of the creek bed about 50 paces South 10° West from location Notice on an old fir tree; thence North 83° East 300 ft; thence North 70° East 1500 feet; thence South 83° West 600 feet; thence South 70° East 1500 feet; and thence North 83° East to the place of beginning.
