

Order permitting sale of Homestead

In the superior Court of the state of Washington for Skamania County.

In the Matter of the estate of Hallie, Wade, insane.

The application of Xenophon Wade, husband of Hallie Wade, insane, having been filed in this Court and coming on this 21st day of March 1910 to be heard; and it appearing to the court that the said Hallie Wade is hopelessly insane and now confined in the State Hospital for Insane at Fort Stevens and is incompetent to convey property; that the petitioner and the said Hallie Wade, insane, are the owners of the following described real estate situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: Lots numbered six and seven and the East one half of the southwest quarter of section six in Township three North of Range eight East of W.M. containing 155.88 acres. That the said Xenophon Wade resides upon the said land and that the same is a homestead duly selected as such. That the value of the said premises is between \$3500.00 and \$4000.00. And it further appearing to the court that due and legal notice of the hearing of the said application was given by publication in the Skamania County Pioneer and to by personal notice to James D. Scott, brother of the said Hallie Wade, the nearest male relative of the said Hallie Wade residing in the State of Washington; and no one appearing to contest the said application, it is therefore Ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said petition be and the same is hereby granted and that the said Xenophon Wade be and he is hereby authorized and permitted to sell, mortgage or convey the said Homestead in the same manner as though the same were not a homestead but separate property.

Notice of Water Claim.

To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that the Highland Apple Co. claim and appropriate the water lying being and flowing on the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 24 Township three north of Range nine East Willamette meridian, at the point where this notice is posted being the place of intended storage and diversion, to the extent of one cubic foot of water per second of time. The purpose of this claim and appropriation is for domestic use and irrigation of the Southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 24 in Township 3 North of Range 9 East of W.M. It is the intention of the appropriators to store and divert the waters herein appropriated by means of a reservoir situated at point at or near the point where this notice is posted, to be transmitted by means of pipe and pressure on the lands to be irrigated.
