




24-The Northwest Discovering Claim of the Samson Testius Lode in Skamania County Washington, discovered and located August 23 1895 by K. Ludloff and described and bounded as follows:- Beginning at the place of discovery in the upper North Toutle Valley Samson Basin, Samson gulch about 4000 feet above Samson Testius Discovering claim and running thence 300 feet-North  $70^{\circ}$  West; thence 1000 feet-North  $20^{\circ}$  East; thence 200 feet-South  $70^{\circ}$  East; thence 1000 feet-South  $20^{\circ}$  West; thence 200 feet to the place of beginning. 
