

Notice of water Appropriation.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States has this day appropriated from the waters of the south fork of the Cispus river two thousand cubic feet of water per second of time, said water to be diverted from said stream about 1000 feet below the junction of the main south fork of the Cispus river and the east fork flowing through what is known as the east canon and the southeast forks and to be carried along the right shore of the Cispus river about twenty-two miles to the place of use. The method of diversion and conveyance will be by dams, flumes, pipes, conduits, siphons & the purpose for which this water is appropriated are for mining, milling, irrigating, manufacturing industrial and for the development of electrical power for furnishing towns and cities with light, heat and power and for furnishing public service corporation with light power, and heat and for all other public uses to which it can be applied. A copy of this notice is posted on a large hemlock tree on the left shore of said stream a little below the confluence of the above streams.
