1<sup>st</sup> That they are lawfully seized of an indefeasible estate in fee simple in and to the above described premises and have good right and full power to convey the same, 2<sup>nd</sup> That the said premises are free from all incumbrances. 3<sup>rd</sup> That they warrant to the said grantee George W. Fisher his heirs and assigns the quiet and peaceable possession of the said premises and will defend the title thereto against all persons who may lawfully claim the same.
