## NOTICE OF WATER RIGHT.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That k. Greene, a citizen of the United States, has this day, in conformity with the Acts of Congress, the laws of the State of Washington, and the local customs of said State, claimed, taken possession of, located and appropriated, and does hereby claim, take possession of, locate and appropriate five hundred cubic fee of water per second of time of the waters lying, being and flowing in the stream known as and named Adams Fork of the Cispus River, which said stream is situated in the County of Skamania, in said State of Washington, he same being the stream on the right bank of which this Notice is posted.

This Notice is posted on a large fir tree about two miles above the head of the canon on the Adams Fork.

The purpose for which said water is claimed and appropriated, and for which the same will be used, are for mining, milling, manufacturing, industrial, irrigation, and for creating a water power to be used for mining, milling, manufacturing, industrial and irrigation purposes, and for creating a water power for the production of electricity to be used for all public, domestic and industrial uses; and for creating electricity for the purpose of supplying cities, towns, and villages with light, heat, and power; and for furnishing public service corporations with light, heat, and power; and for all other public uses to which electricity can be applied. For supplying cities, towns and villages with water, and for water works, and for irrigating lands, and for creating electricity for all public and domestic uses whatsoever. For supplying power for the operation of railroads and other means of transportation, and for all and every public use and service to which water, or water power, or electricity generated from water powercan in any way be used.

Notice is hereby further given that the undersigned, pursuant to this appropriation, intends to divert 500 cubic feet of water per second of time from said stream, at and near the point where this Notice is posted; and to cause said quantity of water to flow therefrom in a northeasterly direction about four miles to the main Cispus River, where a dam or intake is to be constructed for its diversion.

The means by which it is intended to divert said water are by dams, pipes, flumes, ditches, conduits and siphons.

The places where it is intended to use said water are as follows: About twenty two miles in a westerly direction along the right shore of the main Cispus River from the point of intake.
