

Karl Ludloff to Portland & Northwestern exploration & mining company

This indenture, made this 8th day of April, 1897, between Karl Ludloff, of Toledo, Lewis county, State of Washington, party of the first part, and the Portland and Northwestern exploration and mining company, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Oregon, party of the second part,

Witnesseth: that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) to him in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath remised, released, and quitclaimed, and by these presents doth remise, release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns:

All the following described real estate, situate in the St. Helens and Cispus mining district county of Skamania and State of Washington to wit:

Argo lode, Discovery claim. The discovery of said lode is on Poverty Gulch a tributary to the north fork of Lewis river about 1500 feet from the mouth of Jumbo creek, and about a quarter of a mile up said Gulch, supposed to be in Skamania County Wash., boundaries from place of discovery 300 feet south 45 degrees W., thence 750 feet S. 45 degrees E., thence 600 feet N. 45 degrees E., thence 1600 feet N. 45 degrees W., thence 600 feet S. 45 degrees W., thence 700 feet S. 45 degrees E. to point of beginning; directions magnetic, feet linear. Discovered and located July 27th 1896. recorded in skamania county records in book "C", of miscellaneous records, at page 78, on September 22nd, 1896.

Aloo, Black Jack lode, discovery claim, The discovery, ~~the discovery~~ Balies creek, a tributary to Lewis River, on the south slope of Balies mountain, about one mile from mouth of said creek, and is supposed to be in Skamania County, State of Washington boundaries from place of discovery 300 feet N. 80 degrees W., thence 750 feet S. 10 degrees W., thence 600 feet south 80 degrees east, thence 1600 feet N. 10 degrees E., thence 600 feet N. 80 degrees W., thence 750 feet S. 10 degrees W. to place of beginning; directions magnetic, feet linear, discovered and located July 27th, 1896 recorded September 22nd 1896 in book "C", at page 78, of records of miscellaneous Documents of Skamania County, Washington.

Together with all and singular the lodes and veins within the lines of said claim, and the dips, spurs, mines, minerals easements mining fixtures, improvements, rights, privileges, and appurtenances thereunto in any wise belonging.
