Notice is hereby given that R. Greene, citizen of the United States has this day in conformity with the act of Congress, the laws of the state of Washington and the local customs of said State claimed, taken possession of and located and appropriated and does hereby claim, locate take possession of locate and appropriate five hundred cubic feet per second of time of the waters lying and being and flowing in the stream known as and named Centre Glazier Creek which said stream is situated in the county of Skamania in said state of Washington, the same being the stream on the left bank of which this notice is posted. This notice is posted on a small pile tree at the Johnson Creek and Mount Adams trail crossing.
