

Notice of Reservoir Appropriation.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States has this day in conformity with the acts of Congress the laws of the State of Washington and the local customs of said State claimed taken in possession locate and appropriate a reservoir site on the main Cispus river commencing about one half mile below the confluence of the Muddy fork of the Cispus river and the main Cispus river at the head of the first falls below the muddy fork and extending up the main Cispus river a distance of about six miles and besides appropriating the bed and channel of the river for the distance as above mentioned from the head of the first falls below the Muddy to the Mount Adams and Johnson Creek trail crossing The Undersigned hereby claims appropriated locates and takes possession of all of the valley on both sides of the main Cispus river for the distance above mentioned which may be submerged by said reservoir site, the intention being to store in the said reservoir site seventy five thousand million cubic feet of water. The purpose for which said reservoir site is claimed and for which the same will be used is to store water for mining milling manufacturing industrial and irrigation uses and for the creation of water power to be used for mining milling manufacturing industrial and irrigating purposes and creating a water power for the production of electricity to be used for all public domestic and industrial purposes and for creating a water power for the production of electricity for the purpose of supplying cities towns and villages with light, heat and electricity and for public service corporations with light heat and power and for all other public uses to which electricity can be applied For supplying power for the operation of Railroads and other means of transportation and for all and every public and domestic use whatsoever, to which water, or water power or electricity generated from water power can in any way be used. Notice is hereby further given that the undersigned pursuant to this appropriation intends to construct dams flumes, pipes canals and all of the other necessary works for the creation and completion of the reservoir site hereby appropriated. A copy of this notice is posted on a cedar tree at the head of the first falls above mentioned on the left shore about one half mile below the junction of the muddy fork of the Cispus and the main Cispus river.
