To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given that the undersigned Roy P. Ballard, Roy A. Wilson and H. Logan Geary, claim and appropriate the water lying being and flowing on the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 24 Township 3 North of Range 9 East of Willamette meridian at the point where this notice is posted, being the place of intended storage and diversion, to the extent of one cubic foot of water per second of time.
