MABEL EVELYN MOORE To THE PUBLIC  
AFFIDAVIT

MABEL EVELYN MOORE, being first duly sworn on oath deposes and says:

I am the only child of Quincy Wade and Mary E. Wade and am the same person named as  
grantee in that certain deed from Quincy Wade, a widower, to Mabel Evelyn Moore, dated Octo-  
ber 17, 1929, and recorded December 21, 1929 at page 306 Book "W" of Deeds, records of Ska-  
mania County, Washington, covering the West half of the Southeast quarter of Sec. 6 Tp. 3 N.  
R. 8 East of W. M.

That prior to the date of said deed my husband, J. R. Moore deserted me and I secured  
in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for Wahkiakum County, an interlocutory  
order of divorce which said order was granted on the 24th day of December 1929.

That the above mentioned Mary E. Wade died on or about the 26th day of September 1929,  
leaving as her sole heirs at law the above mentioned Quincy Wade and myself. That there  
was no indebtedness against her or her estate and the value of the property belonging to her  
estate was less than the sum of Ten thousand and no/100 (\$10,000.00) Dollars and there is  
no inheritance tax due the State of Washington thereon.

That the above mentioned deed was given for the purpose of settling and partitioning  
my estate, the property above mentioned being conveyed and quitclaimed to me by my father  
in exhange for the conveyance of my interest in and to the home property belonging to my  
father and mother in Sec. 29 Tp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. N. near the Town of Carson and that the  
consideration therefor, <sup>for</sup> said deed was separate property belonging to me to-wit: my interest  
in property descending to me from my said mother.

That my husband, J. R. Moore never acquired or had any right, title or interest in and  
to the aforesaid property.
