POWER OF ATTORNEY

And also for her and in her name, and as her act and deed, to sign, seal, execute deliver and acknowledge such deeds, leases and assignment of leases, covenants, indentures, agreements, mortgages, notes, receipts, evidences of debt, releases and satisfaction of mortgages, judgments and other debts, and such other instruments in writing of whatsoever kind or nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises.
