I, George Rabenau, Sheriff of the County of Okanania in the State of Washington, do hereby certify that pursuant to a judgment of foreclosure and order of sale entered in the Superior Court of said County and State on the 17 day of April A. D. 1899 in an action wherein David Whitney Jr. plaintiff and Jeremiah Buckley and Ella Buckley his wife Defendants

Said order of sale having been duly certified and together with a writ of execution issued therewith to me as such Sheriff directed and delivered, commanding me to sell according to law all or so much as may be necessary of the real property described in said order to satisfy said judgment amounting to the sum of \$2660 and $\frac{25}{100}$ Dollars, inclusive of interest, costs of suit and increased costs, I gave due and legal notice of said sale and on the 10th day of June A. D. 1899 at 10 o'clock A. M., at the front door of the Court House in Stevenson in said County of Okanania, I duly sold said real property at public auction to the highest bidder, to-wit: to David Whitney Jr. who made the highest and best bid therefor at said sale, for the sum of $\$2660 \frac{25}{100}$ $\$8 \frac{30}{100}$ Dollars per acre and being in the aggregate the sum of $\$2660 \frac{25}{100}$ Dollars for the $320 \frac{43}{100}$ acres of said real property situated in said County and State and described in said order as follows:

All of lots (1) and (2) and the south half of the North East quarter of sec (1) in Twp. (2) North of range (5) East situated in Okanania Co., Washington; also the North West quarter of sec. 13 in Twp. (2) North of range (5) East of the Willamette Meridian situated in Okanania Co. State of Washington.

And I do further certify that the said real property was sold in 1 lot or parcel and that the said sum above stated was the highest bid made, and that said sum $2,660 \frac{25}{100}$ the whole price paid for said real property, and that the said property is subject to redemption in one year from date of sale as provided by law.
