ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, A. W. Ocobock, H. E. Noble, and W. L. Archambeau, being desirous of incorporating under the laws of the State of Oregon, for the purpose of engaging in lawful business, do hereby adopt the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, to-wit:

ARTICLE 1

The name of this corporation, and by which it shall be known, is EASTERN INVESTMENT COMPANY LIMITED, and the duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

The enterprise, business, pursuit or occupation in which said corporation proposes to engage, is to buy and sell, acquire or hold notes, mortgages, bonds, warrants, tax certificates or tax deeds, bank stocks, or other investment securities; borrow or loan money; receive deposits; but, lease or otherwise acquire real estate or personal property and to improve and convey the same; issue and dispose of debenture bonds, bearing interest mortgage and pledge its real and personal property; take, have and hold, either as payee, endorsee or assignee, promissory notes, mortgages, bonds, warrants,

and chooses in action, and to collect and enforce the same, and to negotiate loans. This corporation shall have the power to act as agent for other parties, corporation or concerns and generally to do and cause to be done each and every act and thing which it may be, or at any time may be come, requisite, convenient or necessary to do or cause to be done, in order to carry on and transact the business aforesaid.

ARTICLE III

The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be the city of Portland, in the county of Multnomah and State of Oregon; but it shall the power and authority to carry on and transact its ^{said} business and to do and perform any and all of the things aforesaid at other places in the State of Oregon and other States and Territories of the United States, and in Foreign Countries.

ARTICLE IV

The capital stock of this corporation shall be Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.)

ARTICLE V

The capital stock shall be divided into two hundred and fifty (250) shares, and the par value of each share shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.)
