

in the manner provided by law, said lands sold and the proceeds applied in payment of any sum then unpaid upon said notes, including such sum or sums as the court may allow as attorneys fees. And we hereby agree that if the proceeds of said lands shall not satisfy said sums then a deficiency judgment may be entered against us for the balance.
