(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)
(In accordance with the provision of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Hydraulic Engineer thereunder)

This is to certify, that Wauna Lake Club, of Stevenson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Blue Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, for the purposes of domestic use, power and fish propagation under appropriation permit No. 817 of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 1, at page 477, on the 2nd day of February, 1931; that the right hereby confirmed dates from September 30th 1925; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.2 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or if for other purposes, the place where such waters put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Articles of Incorporation
of
Wauna Lake Club

Know All Men by These Presents, That we, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation, not for profit, in accordance with and under the laws of the State of Washington, do hereby make, subscribe and acknowledge these written Articles of Incorporation in triplicate, to-wit:

Article I

The name of this corporation shall be the Wauna Lake Club, and its duration shall be fifty (50) years.

Article II

The objects and purposes of this corporation are as follows:

1. To operate and conduct a recreation, amusement and sporting club at Wauna Lake Skamania County, Washington, for the benefit of such individuals as may become members of such club.
2. That no business shall be conducted for the purpose of profit, and that any charge or charges made to or exacted from the members of such club shall be for the sole purpose of defraying the necessary expenses incident to the up-keep, maintenance and management of said club and grounds.
3. For the purposes above stated to own, hold, rent, lease, mortgage, convey and otherwise acquire and dispose of real property, appertences thereto and buildings thereon.
4. For the purposes and objects aforesaid to buy, own, hold, rent, lease, mortgage, hypothecate, convey and otherwise dispose of machinery, equipment and all kinds and character of personal property.
5. For the objects aforesaid to make, execute, deliver and negotiate bonds, mortgages, bills of sale, contracts and all kinds and character of negotiable papers.
6. To do and perform all acts necessary or incident to the conduct, maintenance and management of said club or to effectuate the objects thereof.

Article III

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be Wauna Lake, Skamania County, Washington.

Article IV

The number of trustees who shall conduct the business of the corporation shall be three (3) and the names and addresses of such trustees who shall manage the business of this corporation for a period of six (6) months hereafter shall be: Charles Gramm, Portland, Oregon; Frank Dye, Vancouver, Washington, and Frank Wilcos, Vancouver, Washington.
