Certificate of Water Right.

This is to certify, that Arthur L. Tibbetts of Willard State of Washington has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Dry Creek a tributary of Little White Salmon River, for the purposes of domestic supplies and irrigation, under appropriation Permit No. 33, of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 2, at page 511 on the 22nd day of May, 1931; that the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2nd, 1918; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

"Resolved, that the President or any Vice-President may from time to time appoint Resident Vice-Presidents, Resident Assistant Secretaries and Attorneys-in-fact to represent and act for and on behalf of the Company, and either the President or any Vice-President, the Board of Directors or the Executive Committee may at any time remove any such Resident Vice-President or Resident Assistant Secretaries and Attorneys-in-fact and revoke the power and authority given him; and be it further

"Resolved, that Attorneys-in-Fact may be given full power and authority to execute for and in the name and on behalf of the Company, any and all bonds, recognizances, contracts of indemnity and other writings obligatory in the nature of a bond, recognizance or conditional undertaking, and any such instrument executed by any such Attorney-in-Fact shall be as binding upon the Company as if signed by the President and sealed and attested by the Secretary; and be it further

"Resolved, that the Attorneys-in-Fact are hereby authorized to verify any affidavit required to be attached to bonds, recognizances or contracts of indemnity, policies of insurance and all other writings obligatory in the nature thereof."
