 party of the second part, the following described premises, to-wit:

 Northwest quarter (S¹/₂ N.W¹/₄) of Section numbered twenty-eight (28) in Township Three
 (37) North of Range Nine (97) East of Willamette Meridian in Multnomah County in the
 State of Washington, Together with tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto
 belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same, with the appurtenances,
