Leat, Portland, Oregon, Three hundred Dollars in Gold coin of the United States of America, of the present standard value, with interest thereon in like Gold coin, at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from date until paid, for value received. Interest to be paid semi annually and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately Due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note, or any portion thereof, I promises and agree to pay in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute, such additional sum in like Gold coin as the court may adjudge reasonable for attorney's fees to be allowed in said suit or action.

Now if the sum of money due upon said instrument shall be paid according to agreement therein expressed, this conveyance shall be void, but in case default shall be made in payment of the principal or interest as above provided, then the said Albie Fliss and his legal representatives may sell the premises above described, with all and every of the appurtenances, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of the money arising from such sale, after the said principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and the expenses, if any there be, paid over to the said Lora A. Moffett her heirs and assigns, and the said parties of the first part, for their heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant and agree to pay the said party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns, the said sum of money above mentioned.
