KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT JOHN DURKIN, THE OWNER IN HIS OWN SEPARATE ESTATE OF THE RIGHTS HEREBY CONVEYED, PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE SUM OF ONE DOLLAR TO HIM IN HAND PAID BY C. C. HON, PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, THE RECEIPT WHEREOF IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, DOES HEREBY GRANT AND CONVEY UNTO THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES AND EASEMENTS, IN LAND SITUATED AND BEING IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, TO-WIT:

THE RIGHT TO DEVELOP AND TO TAKE WATER FROM A CERTAIN SPRING SITUATED ON THE LEFT BANK OF THE SMALL STREAM KNOWN AS ANDERSON CREEK, ABOUT 700 FEET IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION FROM THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF SAID CREEK WITH THE STATE ROAD No. 8, SAID SPRING BEING IN THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SEC 36 TP 3 N R 7 E. W.M.; ALSO THE RIGHT TO AN EASEMENT ON OVER AND ACROSS THE LAND OWNED BY THE SAID PARTY OF THE FIRST PART IN SAID SEC 36 TP 3 N R 7 E. W.M. FOR A PIPE LINE FROM SAID SPRING TO THE LAND OF THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, WHERE THE SAME IS NOW LOCATED AND CONSTRUCTED, TO-GETHER WITH THE RIGHT TO GO UPON SAID LAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPAIRING, REPLACING AND MAINTAINING THE SAID PIPE LINE, AND THE INTAKES AND RESERVOIRS AT SAID SPRING; ALSO, GRANTING THE RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A RESERVOIR AT SAID SPRING FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTING AND STORING WATER FOR THE USE OF THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.
