poses of Irrigation and domestic supply under Appropriation Permit No. 1009, of the State
Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected
in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor
of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 2, at page 600, on the 5th
day of May, 1932; that the right hereby confirmed dates from May 12th, 1927; that the amount
of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid
is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.05 cubic feet per second.
