Know all men by these Presents, That we, Edward Underwood and his wife Isabelle Underwood the parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and fifty (\$850.) Dollars, Gold Coin of the United States of America, to us in hand paid by Axel N. Rahm of Hood River Oregon, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, Transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part, a certain Indenture of Mortgage, bearing date the 3rd day of December A.D. One thousand nine hundred and three, made and executed by W. F. Calk and Lottie D. Calk, husband and wife, to the said party of the first part, to secure the payment of the sum of eight hundred and fifty (\$850.)
