This Indenture Witnesseth that William A. Orser and Eliza S. Orser, his wife, in consideration of three hundred and thirty one and $\frac{75}{100}$ Dollars to us paid in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Robert Rand, the following described premises, to-wit: The Northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-four (24) Township No three (3) North Range nine (9) East of Willamette Meridian, containing forty acres more or less, in Skamania County, State of Washington, together with the Tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Robert Rand, his heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of three hundred and thirty one and $\frac{75}{100}$ hundred Dollars, and the interest thereon in accordance with the tenor of three promissory notes of which the following are copies to-wit:
