Union Indemnity Co. to H. T. Hansen.

Revocation of Power of Attorney No. 4143.

Know All Men by these presents: That whereas, the Union Indemnity Company, of New Orleans, Louisiana, did on the 21st day of June, 1929, by a power of Attorney duly executed by Frank E. Sprague, its Vice President and C. C. Brant, its Assistant Secretary, there-by nominate, constitute and appoint H. T. Hansen of Tacoma, Washington its true and lawful agent and attorney-in-fact, to make, execute, seal and deliver for and on its behalf as surety, and all bonds, recognizances, obligations, stipulations, undertakings or anything in the nature of any of them, in no one instance to exceed the sum of unlimited Dollars, which are or may be allowed, required or permitted by law, statute, rule, regulation, contract or otherwise, all as described and authorized in the Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Union Indemnity Company, which forms a part of said Power of Attorney and did by said Power of Attorney provide for the execution and acknowledgement of such bonds by said H. T. Hansen of Tacoma, Washington in pursuance of the presents therein contained should be as binding upon the said Company as fully and amply to all intents and purposes as if said bonds, recognizances, obligations, stipulations, undertakings or anything in the nature of them had been duly executed and acknowledged by the regularly elected officers of the Company in their own proper persons; and

Whereas, the Union Indemnity Company, is desirous of revoking the powers given to said H. T. Hansen of Tacoma, Washington as aforesaid:

Now therefore, the Union Indemnity Company, by Frank E. Sprague, its Vice-President, and C. C. Brant, its Assistant Secretary, does hereby revoke and make void all and singular the powers and authorities by the said recited powers of attorney given to or conferred upon the said H. T. Hansen of Tacoma, Washington.
