STATE OF WASHINGTON TO J. S. JOHNSTON NOTICE OF WATER APPROPRIATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: THAT THE UNDERSIGNED, A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, HAS THIS TWENTY-SECOND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1921, APPROPRIATED THE WATER IN CRYSTAL CREEK TO THE EXTENT OF SEVENTY (70) CUBIC FEET PER SECOND OF TIME.

THAT THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND APPROPRIATION OF SAID WATER IS AT THE CRYSTAL FALLS IN SECTION FOURTEEN (14), TOWNSHIP NINE (9) NORTH, RANGE SIX (6) EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON.

THAT THE PURPOSE OF SAID APPROPRIATION IS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF POWER TO BE USED IN MINING, SMELTING AND REDUCTION OF ORES AND MINERALS AND FOR LIGHTING PURPOSES AND FOR OPERATING RAILROADS.

THAT SUCH POWER WILL BE DEVELOPED AT OR ABOUT 1,000 FEET FROM SAID POINT OF DIVERSION AND WILL BE TRANSMITTED FOR USE IN THE MT. ST. HELENS MINING DISTRICT OF SAID COUNTY AND ON THE COLUMBIA RIVER AND BETWEEN SAID MINING DISTRICT AND SAID RIVER.

THAT SAID WATER WILL BE DIVERTED AND STORED BY MEANS OF CONCRETE DAMS AND WILL BE CONVEYED TO THE PLACES TO INTENDED USE BY IRON PIPE.

THAT THE UNDERSIGNED CLAIMS THE RIGHT TO THE USE OF SAID WATER UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON AND OF THE UNITED STATES, BY VIRTUE OF THIS APPROPRIATION.
