For, according to the provisions of Section 1573 (as amended by Act of Congress approved August 22, 1912) of the Revised Statutes, if within four months from this date the said S. A. True shall present this, his, Honorable Discharge, at any United States Naval Rendezvous, and is found specially qualified, and shall reenlist for four years, then he shall be entitled to pay during the said four years equal to that to which he would have been entitled had he been employed in actual service.
