Know all men by these presents, that we, O. C. McLeod, and Florence M. McLeod his wife of Sumpter, Oregon in consideration of One Dollar to us paid by Henry H. Coe of Portland Oregon, do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said Henry H. Coe and unto his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

All our right, title and interest in and to The Chicago North West Discovery Claim, the same being a Quartz mining claim situated in Saint Helens Mining District in said Skamania County, State of Washington.

The point of discovery on said claim, which is marked by a stake, is situated about fifteen (15) feet South Easterly from the tunnel on said claim, and about thirty (30) feet Westerly from the Broadbent Cabin. It is about one quarter of a mile North Westerly from the Lauman Cabin about the same distance in nearly the same direction from the North Toutle River, about one mile Westerly from Beacon Mountain and about eight miles Northeasterly from Mount Saint Helens. Said claim is distinctly marked on the ground and is staked at each corner by stakes squared, showing more than three feet out of the ground, being more than four inches in diameter and each bearing the name of this Lode and claim, and the date of the location thereof.
