That I am a resident and inhabitant of Fortland, Multnomah County, Orecon, and am over the age of twenty-one years.

That I am the grantee in that certain lease dated September 1st, 1909, and recorded in Fook 2, page 115, Agreements and Leases for Skarania County, Washington, on the 24th day of May, 1910; said instrument granted to me a right of way from A. Blazier to construct a logging railroad upon the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of section 25, Township 2 North range 5 E. W. M., Skamania County, Washington.

That I am also the J. E. Blazier mentioned in that certain lease from A. Blazier to the Washington Northern Railroad Company, an Oreron corporation, which said lease is dated June 2, 1910 and recorded on June 7, 1910 in Book 2 of Agreements and Leases at page 120, Skamania County, Washington, covering the mame property, and in which lease it is stated that I had assigned my interest in said land to the Cape Horn Railroad Company, and all rights under which pass d to the Washington Northern Railroad Company, an Oregon corporation.
