I. J. E. Blazier, being first duly sworn, upon oath depose and say:

That I am a resident and inhabitant of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, and am over the age of twenty-one years.

That I am the grantee in that certain lease dated September 1st, 1909, and recorded in Book 2, page 115, Agreements and Leases for Skamania County, Washington, on the 24th day of May, 1910; said instrument granted to me a right of way from A. Blazier to construct a logging railroad upon the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter, and the North half of the Southwest quarter of Section 25, Township 2 North range 6 E. W. M., Skamania County, Washington.

That I am also the J. E. Blazier mentioned in that certain lease from A. Blazier to the Washington Northern Railroad Company, an Oregon corporation, which said lease is dated June 2, 1910 and recorded on June 7, 1910 in Book 2 of Agreements and Leases at page 120, Skamania County, Washington, covering the same property, and in which lease it is stated that I had assigned my interest in said land to the Cape Horn Railroad Company, and all rights under which passed to the Washington Northern Railroad Company, an Oregon corporation.

That both of said leases mentioned were granted for the purpose of constructing logging railroads; that about 1910 and some time thereafter I was engaged in the logging business in Skamania County, Washington, but am no longer engaged therein; that the Washington Northern Railroad Company has taken up all tracks laid by it across said land and that said corporation has long since ceased to exist, being dissolved by proclamation of the Governor of the State of Oregon January 11, 1916 for failure to pay the annual license fees; that I was also President of the said corporation and know that it no longer claims any interest in said land by virtue of said lease.

That said A. Blazier mentioned as grantor in said lease was my father.

In Sec. 29 tp. 2 N. R. 7 E. W. M. at a point S 15° 14' E from the quarter corner on the north line of said sec. 29 a distance of 2600 feet.

Both of said locations being plated and described on map filed in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington on the 9th day of May 1932 under file No. 17962.

Also one 16 foot, tarred row boat.

And the party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree to and with the party of the second part that he and his predecessors in interest have complied with all the laws of the State of Washington relating to the location of said fishing locations; that the
