MOTICE OF WATER APPROPRIATION

MOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: THAT THE UNDERSTRIED, A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES HAS THIS TWENTY-SECOND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1921, APPROPRIATED THE WATER IN BRIZZLY CREEK, TO THE EXTENT OF TWO (2) CUBIC FEET PER SECOND OF TIME,

THAT THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND APPROPRIATION OF SAID WATER IS AT THE GRIZZLY FALLS, ABOUT ONE THOUSAND (1,000) FEET FROM THE MOUTH OF TUNNELL NO. 1 OK GRIZZLY No. 1 MINE IN SECTION TWENTY (20), TOWNSHIP TEN (10) NORTH, RANGE SIX (6) EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, SKAMANIA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON.

THAT THE PURPOSE OF SAID APPROPRIATION IS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF POWER TO BE USED IN MINING, SMELTING AND REDUCTION OF ORES AND MINERALS AND FOR LIGHTING PURPOSES AND FOR OPERATING MAILROADS.

THAT SUCH POWER WILL BE CEVELOPED NEAR THE MOUTH OF SAID TUNNEL AND ABOUT ONE THOUSAND (1,000) FERT FROM THE POINT OF DIVERSION THEREOF, AND WILL BE TRANS-MITTED FOR USE IN THE ST. HELENS MINING DISTRICT OF SAID COUNTY.

THAT SAID WATER WILL DIVERTED AND STORED BY MEANS OF CONCRETE AND WOODEN DAMS AND WILL BE CONVEYED TO THE PLACE OF INTENDED UNE BY IRON PIPE.

THAT THE UNDERSTONED CLAIMS THE RIGHT TO THE USE OF SAID WATER UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON AND OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, BY VIRTUE OF SAID APPROPRIATION.
