State of Washington to James McNicholl

Certificate record No. 2, page No. 727. State of Washington, County of Skamania.
Certificate of Water Right.

This is to certify, that James McNicholl, of Cook State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek a tributary of Little White Salmon River for the purposes of domestic supply, under Appropriation Permit No. 2048, of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 2, at page 727 on the 22nd day of September, 1933; that the right hereby confirmed dates from April 6th, 1933, that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Section 39, Chapter 117 Session Laws 1917.
